This form includes all the formats required. Please use it as a model or template. The whole abstract, including all the headings (title of the paper, authors, institutions or companies, first author's postal address, and e-mail of all authors) should not be less than 500 nor more than 2000 words following the submission template format with top and bottom margins of 2.5 cm, and left and right margins of 3 cm. All the text goes in Times New Roman 12, with the following details:

- Title of the paper: left margin, uppercase, bold.
- Authors: left margin, first names in normal characters, last names in uppercase.
- Institutions or companies: left margin; for various authors from different institutions or companies, use superscript numerals: ^{1,2,3}.
- Postal address: only for the first author or main author, left margin.
- E-mails: in the same order as authors, separated by commas, left margin.
- Text of the abstract: justified, all paragraphs with a 0.5 cm indent in the first line, except for the first paragraph (no indent).
- Images, figures and formula can be included.

Leave one blank line between title of the paper and names of authors, and two blank lines between e-mails and text of the abstract.

At the bottom of the page, after the text of the abstract, specify your preference, either for oral or poster presentation. Oral presentations will be allowed 15-20 minutes (invited lectures 30-40 minutes), and posters should be presented as a single sheet world format (F4, 90 x 128 cm, portrait format).

The AIC 2011 Scientific Committee reserves the right to schedule any papers accepted as oral presentations in the topic or sub-topic section that best suits the content and organisation of the programme. Final acceptance of papers for oral presentations will be decided by the AIC 2011 Scientific Committee.

Submit the extended abstract in English. Please send your submission as both an attached WORD-file (DOC or DOCX files) and a PDF-file (Acrobat), before **15 November 2010**, to: info@aic2011.org

Along with a peer review and letter of acceptance, accepted authors will also receive format requirements and guidelines for short abstracts as well as full papers (final texts).

Deadline for Submission of Final Texts: **5 March 2011**

All papers accepted by the AIC 2011 Scientific Committee with at least one registered author per submission participating at the conference will be included in the AIC 2011 Conference Proceedings.
